



Seasonal Part-time Firefighter

Nehalem Bay Fire & Rescue District is recruiting qualified applicants to fill the position of Seasonal Part-time Firefighter.

OVERVIEW

June – October, or until OSFM Grant funds are exhausted.
Minimum of 20 hours per week (two 10-hour shifts)
Compensation: \$22 per hour. *This is a non-exempt position.*

DUTIES

This position reports directly to the duty officer and the fire chief. The firefighter's primary scope of work involves responding to emergency and non-emergency calls for service, and facility, apparatus, and equipment maintenance.

REQUIREMENTS

Adherence to Nehalem Bay Fire and Rescue District's policies; including tobacco, drug, and alcohol use, is required at all times during employment.

Candidate must possess a valid, insurable, Oregon driver's license.

Candidate must be physically able to perform the functions of the position.

Candidate must have current certification as NFPA Firefighter I or higher.

Candidate must have current certification as NWCG FFT2.

Candidate must have current certification as Oregon EMR or higher.

Candidate must have current certification as NFPA Driver or EVOC.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Performs emergency response duties consistent with those of a firefighter.
- Deploys as a member of the Wildland Fire Task Force for pre-positioning and conflagrations.
- Performs EMS response within scope of practice at the level of EMR or higher.
- Performs facility janitorial functions including cleaning and ordering supplies.
- Performs required incident reports related to emergency response.
- Performs facility landscaping/upkeep as needed.
- Performs facility, apparatus, and equipment inspections and maintenance as required.
- Other duties as assigned not listed, as determined by the duty officer.

These are a general statement of duties and do not reflect the full aspect of the Seasonal Part-time Firefighter position.
